## What is Non-Violent Civic Action?

There have been many examples of ordinary citizens who used non-violent civic action to better their community, workplace, and country. The right to vote, a minimum wage, an eight-hour workday, prohibitions against child labor, and safeguards for physical safety at the workplace emerged because of concerned citizens.

Citizens involved in nonviolent civic action do not challenge their opponents by using violence or the threat of violence, which are often the tools of repressive authorities. Methods of nonviolent civic action include acts of peaceful opposition or persuasion (protest marches, letter-writing campaigns), acts or campaigns of noncooperation (boycotts, strikes), and rejection of authority (refusal to accept government actions, disobedience or non-compliance).

People use nonviolent civic action to achieve political, economic, social, and environmental advances around the world. More recently, it has been described as "people power."
